Pursuant to Clean Energy Guidance Document CE-01: Utility Energy Efficiency Program Cycle, effective July 28, 2016, from the Director of the Office of Clean Energy, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“Distribution” or the “Company”) hereby submits this Energy Efficiency Transition Implementation Plan (“ETIP”) Revision Letter.

Distribution’s most recent ETIP filing, titled “Conservation Incentive Program – Updated 2015 Energy Efficiency Transition Implementation Plan for the 2016 to 2018 Period,” was filed with the New York State Public Service Commission on December 1, 2016 in Cases 15-M-0252 and 07-G-0141. Since that filing was completed, the Company has made the following changes:

- Programmable thermostats were removed from Table 4B, as a rebate being offered to residential customers during 2017, with an effective date of February 1, 2017; and
- Programmable thermostats were removed from Table 10B, as a rebate being offered to non-residential customers during 2017, with an effective date of February 1, 2017.
