Pursuant to Clean Energy Guidance Document CE-01: Utility Energy Efficiency Program Cycle, effective July 28, 2016, from the Director of the Office of Clean Energy, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“Distribution” or the “Company”) hereby submits this Energy Efficiency Transition Implementation Plan (“ETIP”) Revision Letter.

Distribution’s most recent ETIP filing, titled “Conservation Incentive Program – Updated 2017 Energy Efficiency Transition Implementation Plan for the 2017-2020 Program Years,” was filed with the New York State Public Service Commission on December 20, 2017, in Cases 15-M-0252 and 07-G-0141. Since that filing was completed, the Company has made the following change:

- Footnote 19 is hereby removed from Page 8. The Technical Resource Manual Management Committee (“TRM MC”) approved the clothes dryer measure for use in the Commercial and Industrial sector, via the TRM MC’s December 27, 2017 filing in Case 14-M-0101, Case 15-M-0252, and Matter 15-01319. With the completion of this filing, the assumption originally included in Footnote 19 is no longer needed.
